### Dear Quilter or Scrapper,

We look forward to your arrival and again want you to know that we will do every thing to make your stay as enjoyable as possible.

We are sending you this letter to help you plan and pack for your trip.

**Meals Package:** If your package includes Dinner, one night (pizzas, salad, and dessert) will be served and a Full Country Breakfast each morning.

Check-in after 3:00 pm and check-out by noon.

### Things Provided:

The Quilt/Cropping room is available 24 hours a day  
Up to seven 6-ft tables  
Use of Living Room (television/stereo)  
There are two refrigerators (one larger on Second Floor, one smaller in quilt/crop room)  
A small 9 1/2 X 11 microwave for your use in the quilt/crop room  
Iced Tea, Soda, Coffee, Hot Tea, and Cocoa  
Lighting, trash bags and chairs at your tables  
The pool (in season) and hot tub are open 10am to 10pm. Pool towels and robes available.  
Design Board 70 X 48 for Quilters  
2 Ironing Boards and Irons  
A counter height cutting table  
A 6 X 12 Cricket Machine for Scrapbookers w/limited supply of cartridges

### Things you can bring:

You are free to bring all the snacks and beverages you would like (alcohol is o.k.).  
Bathing suits  
I-pods and CD's  
Paper plates and utensils for snacks you bring

### Additional Meal Suggestions:

Some groups just bring snacks for midday and go out for early dinner.  
Bring pre-made items that you can refrigerate or microwave  
Within one mile is Lovington Café, Vitos Italian, Chinese take-out, Subway and McDonalds  
Devil's Backbone Brewery – 20 minutes away – Pub and Full Fare menu

Note: if you are fully occupying both houses, you have full use of the kitchen at the Apple Blossom.

### Other Things to do:

Take a walk on the trail around our property or Hike up Crabtree Falls (largest waterfall this side of the Mississippi)
